

GEO-ENERGY EUROPE meeting with Geothermal Development Company meeting

Brussels 18.11.2021

The GEO-ENERGY EUROPE metacluster partners have met with Geothermal Development Company through a webworkshop. This meeting comes to consolidate the relationship between the GEO-ENERGY EUROPE partners and the Kenyan geothermal community, with the objective to facilitate the implementation of joint projects between European and Kenyan companies.

The GEO-ENERGY Metacluster is already involved in establishing partnership with Kenyan stakeholders from the geothermal community, despite the challenges posed by the COVID pandemic in consolidating the international geothermal community. Kenya, a country with a tremendous potential for geothermal power production, cogeneration and heating and cooling, is more than ever looking at geothermal to achieve its development goals, and GDC is one of the companies looking to achieve this ambition.

GDC is a public Kenyan company, formed in 2008 to promote the development of Kenya's geothermal resources. It is focusing on the development of new geothermal projects in Africa's largest geothermal user – and one of the leading global user of geothermal electricity. GDC develops fields and provides the steam to KenGEN for the production of geothermal electricity.
